
Dear Mr. Leonardi and Mr. Accord:

We recognize that a number of Part-Time Postmasters (PTPMs) working in six-hour offices, whether Part-Time Post Offices (PTPOs) or Remotely Managed Post Offices (RMPOs) reporting to Administrative Post Offices (APOs), receive hourly pay less than Postal Support Employees (PSEs) in RMPOs.

Consistent with the consultation you had with Doug A. Tulino, Vice President, Labor Relations, where you agreed to address this issue outside of the pay consultation process outlined in Title 39 US Code § 1004 (e), we agree to adjust the pay of PTPMs in the situation outlined above. Those PTPMs will receive an hourly rate equal to the PSEs referenced above.
