Background

The 2018 primary season is here and the Postal Service[™] is preparing for the November 2018 general election. There will be several congressional, gubernatorial, state, and local races. Thus, proper handling of Election Mail and Political Mail is critical.

Concerns have been raised about how long it takes for Election Mail and Political Mail to reach voters. The Postal Service takes these concerns very seriously. Coast to coast, plans are in place to ensure the timely receipt, processing, and delivery of Election Mail and Political Mail.

Generally, citizens use one of the following three methods to cast their votes:

- A traditional polling place via electronic or paper ballot,
- An absentee paper ballot, or
- Early in-person voting.

Although traditional poll voting is still the preferred method, voting by mail is increasing in popularity across broad segments of the American electorate. In the 2014 midterm federal election, 25 percent of voters cast ballots by mail — an increase of 9.5 percent over the 2010 midterm election.

Key Dates

- Primaries began March 6 in Texas and will continue through November.
- General Election November 6.

Key Elections

- General Election November 6.
- A total of 470 seats in the U.S. Congress are up for election:
 - 35 Senate seats AZ, CA, CT, DE, FL, HI, IN, MA, MD, ME, MI, MN (2), MO, MS (2), MT, ND, NE, NJ, NM, NV, NY, OH, PA, RI, TN, TX, UT, VA, VT, WA, WI, WV, and WY.
 - All 435 House seats.
- 36 Gubernatorial seats AK, AL, AR, AZ, CA, CO, CT, FL, GA, HI, IA, ID, IL, KS, MA, MD, ME, MI, MN, NE, NH, NM, NV, NY, OH, OK, OR, PA, RI, SC, SD, TN, TX, VT, WI, and WY.

Election Mail and Political Mail Overview

What is Election Mail?

Election Mail is any item mailed to or from authorized election officials that enables citizens to participate in the voting process, such as balloting materials, voter registration cards, absentee applications, and polling place notifications.

What is Political Mail?

Political Mail includes Political Campaign Mail and Political Message Mail.

- Political Campaign Mail is any material mailed at First-Class Mail[®] or USPS Marketing Mail[®] prices for political campaign purposes by a registered political candidate, a campaign committee (federal, state, or local), or a committee of a political party (e.g., Democratic National Committee or Republican Congressional Campaign Committee) to promote political candidates, referendums, or political campaigns.
- Political Message Mail is any material mailed at First-Class Mail or USPS Marketing Mail prices by a political action committee (PAC), super-PAC, or other organization engaging in issue advocacy or voter mobilization.

Political Mail may be sent for any public election — partisan or nonpartisan — for which there is a ballot. Political Mail is identified using red Tag 57, *Political Campaign Mailing.*

Plan Objectives

- Educate and inform the public on proper mail handling, key dates, and general tips for Election Mail and Political Mail.
- Reinforce the message that the Postal Service takes its job of delivering ballots and other Election Mail and Political Mail very seriously.
- Ensure the correct use of Tag 57, Political Campaign Mailing. Political Message Mail (mailings from certain groups about issue advocacy or voter mobilization) and Political Campaign Mail (mailings from certain groups or individuals related to a candidate, campaign, or referendum) both use Tag 57.
- Ensure the correct use of Tag 191, Domestic and International Mail-In Ballots. Postal Service employees must correctly identify and promptly process this mail.
- Ensure the correct use of the official Election Mail logo. It may be used on all Election Mail, including ballots.
- Inform election officials that ballots will be handled correctly. Educate them on service standards so they can ensure ballots are mailed and returned by the deadline.

 Ensure Postal Service employees know that they must always promptly and efficiently handle Election Mail or Political Mail with equal care and attention.

Key Messages

- U.S. Mail[®] services are an important part of the U.S. election process. The Postal Service will ensure the dependable and timely delivery of Election Mail and Political Mail.
- Customers can trust the Postal Service to deliver Vote-By-Mail ballots in a timely manner.
- The Postal Service offers a state-by-state outreach program to ensure election boards, political candidates, and mailers are aware of the deadlines for Election Mail and Political Mail.
- The Postal Service takes pride in the popularity of U.S. Mail as an efficient and effective means for citizens to participate in the voting process.
- The Postal Service expects to handle millions of ballots this election cycle — proof that mail is a dependable and protected way to cast a vote. Voter communication ensures that ballots have sufficient time to be processed, delivered, and counted.
- The Postal Service suggests that election officials include a voter notification in the ballot material packet to ensure the timely delivery of ballots. Return by mail dates are based on state and local laws, but the Postal Service recommends the following:
 - Domestic non-military voters are advised to mail ballots at least one week before the due date to account for any unforeseen events or weather issues.
 - Military personnel serving overseas, such as Army Post Office/Foreign Post Office (APO/FPO) voters, must follow the return by mail date for their location (see usps.com/electionmail).

Key Voter Message — Return Ballots

Customers who opt to vote through U.S. Mail service must understand their local jurisdiction's requirements for timely submission of absentee ballots, including postmarking requirements. Voters must contact their local election officials for questions about local deadlines. The Postal Service recommends that voters mail their ballots at least 1 week before the due date to account for any unforeseen events or weather issues.

Key Election Official Message — Ballots

Whether using First-Class Mail or USPS Marketing Mail service, customers are encouraged to work closely with local Postal Service Election Mail coordinators to determine delivery times for the mailings. For coordinator contact information, visit *usps.com/electionmail*.

Election Mail

Absentee Ballots

Not all voters can get to the polling place on Election Day. An absentee ballot is the printed ballot marked by an absent voter, sealed in a special envelope, and given or mailed to the municipal clerk.

Each election cycle presents a different set of parameters for ballot creation and for the size and weight of the return mailpiece. As a result, many voters do not know the correct amount of postage required to return their ballots by mail. Election officials must consult with Postal Service officials to determine the proper postage required for mailing ballots to voters and for voters mailing ballots to election officials.

Absentee and Early Voting

Most states have a method for eligible voters to cast ballots before Election Day, either during the early voting period or by requesting an absentee ballot. In 13 states, early voting is not available, and in 20 states, a reason is required to request an absentee ballot. States typically offer three ways for voters to cast a ballot before Election Day:

- 1. Early Voting. In 37 states (including three that mail ballots to all voters for every election) and the District of Columbia, any qualified voter may cast a ballot in person during a designated period before Election Day. No excuse or justification is required.
- 2. Absentee Voting. All states will mail an absentee ballot to qualified voters who request one. The voter may return the ballot by mail or in person. In 20 states, a reason is required, while 27 states and the District of Columbia permit any qualified voter to vote absentee without offering a justification. Some states offer a permanent absentee ballot list. Once a voter asks to be added to the list, he or she will automatically receive an absentee ballot for all future elections.
- **3. Mail Voting.** A ballot is automatically mailed to every eligible voter (no request or application is necessary). In-person voting sites may also be available. Three states mail ballots to all eligible voters for every election. Other states may provide this option for some types of elections.

Vote-By-Mail

According to the National Conference of State Legislatures, 22 states have provisions allowing certain elections to be conducted entirely by mail. For these elections, all registered voters receive a ballot in the mail. Typically, the voter marks the ballot, puts it in a secrecy envelope or sleeve, places it into a separate mailing envelope, signs an affidavit on the exterior of the mailing envelope, and returns the package via mail or by dropping it off.

Ballots are mailed in advance of Election Day so voters have an "election period" instead of a single day to vote. All-mail elections, known as "Vote-By-Mail" can be seen as absentee voting for everyone.

As of January 2017, three of the 22 states — Oregon (2000), Washington (2011), and Colorado (2013) — hold all elections entirely by mail. California (2016) will begin holding all-mail elections in 2018. Traditional in-person voting precincts are not available in these three states. Instead, voters return ballots by mail, in a drop-off location, and in some cases vote in-person at voter centers. Other states permit all-mail elections in certain circumstances, such as for special districts, municipal elections, when candidates run unopposed, or at the discretion of the county clerk.

Generally, states begin providing all-mail elections only in certain circumstances, and then add additional opportunities as citizens become familiar with procedures. For more information, visit *ncsl.org/research/elections-andcampaigns/all-mail-elections.aspx*.

The National Conference of State Legislatures also reports that at least 17 states and the District of Columbia allow some form of permanent absentee voting. In some states, this system is called "permanent mail-in voting." Permanent absentee voting operates in a similar manner to all-mail elections. Voters in these states can sign up to have a ballot automatically mailed for every election where the voter is eligible.

Military – APO/FPO/DPO

Key Messages

- Even in times of war, the Postal Service has delivered the most fundamental symbol of democracy — a ballot. The Postal Service is honored to provide the brave men and woman serving abroad in the military with the opportunity to vote.
- Any American voter living overseas can mail his or her completed ballot back to the United States free of charge at the nearest American embassy, consulate, or Diplomatic Post Office (DPO). If the voter has authorized access to a military base, he or she can mail a ballot free of charge at the nearest Army Post Office (APO) or Foreign Post Office (FPO).
- For the 2018 midterm election, special procedures for APO/FPO/DPO absentee ballots are in effect between

September 1 and November 6. During this time, the Postal Service will provide special handling for dispatch via the International Service Centers (ISCs).

 The Postal Service recommends that voters return ballots by these mailing dates (see usps.com/electionmail).

Military – APO/FPO/DPO Absentee Ballots

The Postal Service and the Military Postal Service have joined forces to provide special handling of absentee ballots to overseas military personnel. The Postal Service is committed to ensuring that everyone who votes by mail experiences an efficient process.

Here is a summary of special procedures for APO/FPO/ DPO absentee ballots:

- Election officials must mail absentee ballots at least 45 days before the November 6 election.
- All military absentee ballots mailed by election officials from September 1 through November 6 will be subject to special handling procedures.
- Local election offices must segregate military absentee ballots to the Chicago ISC and the Miami ISC gateways. At ISCs, absentee ballots receive special handling including accelerated sortation, special tray identification, and priority transportation.
- APO/FPO absentee ballots will be sent from local Post OfficeTM locations to the nearest Processing and Distribution Center for further handling. Postal service employees may identify trays or containers of absentee ballot mail using Tag 191, *Domestic and International Mail-in Ballots*, and present them to the Post Office facility.

Military – APO/FPO/DPO Returning Absentee Ballots

Military personnel with APO/FPO/DPO addresses can return absentee ballots via Priority Mail Express[®] using Label 11-DOD, *DOD Express Mail Label Absentee Ballot.* The label includes "Waiver of Signature" and "Guaranteed by End of Day" endorsements, so ballots can be delivered the day they arrive at the destination Post Office.

Label 11-DOD




- The Military Postal Service distributes Label 11-DOD overseas and pays for the postage.
- The Priority Mail Express ballot label is only for absentee ballots mailed from Military Post Office facilities overseas.
- Voters may use the label on any size ballot envelope and must always affix it in the upper right corner.
- Voters keep part of the label to use the tracking number to track their ballots.
- At ISCs, absentee ballots receive special handling including accelerated sortation, special tray identification, and priority transportation.
- Overseas U.S. military and civilian citizens must return their absentee ballots via APO/FPO/DPO locations.
- The ballots arrive by international transportation at one of the Postal Service gateway offices for Customs clearance and initial processing at select designated offices.
- At these facilities, the mail is processed by postal automation equipment in an initial domestic primary sort for distribution throughout the United States.

Tag 191

Tag 191, *Domestic and International Mail-In Ballots,* is a green container tag used by election officials to identify trays and sacks of ballot mail destined for either domestic or international addresses. The tag (shown right) provides greater visibility to ballot mail during Postal Service handling.

Political Mail

Objectives

- Ensure the correct use of Tag 57, Political Campaign Mailing.
- Ensure Postal Service employees know that they must always promptly and efficiently process and deliver Political Mail. Mail entry personnel must ensure that all qualifying mail is documented as Political Mail.

Key Messages

- U.S. Mail services are an important part of the U.S. election process. The Postal Service considers the dependable and timely delivery of Political Mail promoting candidates and social causes essential to the success of the election mailing season.
- The best campaign is a multi-channel campaign. For candidates, Political Campaign Mail can help them reach constituents directly.
- Use Tag 57, Political Campaign Mailing, for the following mailings:
 - Any political campaign mailing by a registered political candidate, campaign committee, and committee of a political party; or
 - Political message mailing by a PAC, super-PAC, or other organization engaging in issue advocacy or voter mobilization.

Why Political Mail?

- Mail can reach 100 percent of targeted voters.
- Mail prompts action, often through other channels.
- Mail has been tested and is proven effective.

Political Mail Tools

- The Political Mail website (see <u>deliverthewin.com</u>) provides information on key contacts and other valuable resources, and serves as an online platform to promote direct mail through the following materials:
 - Educational articles,
 - White papers,
 - Case studies, and
 - Videos.
- Connections to digital content, such as augmented reality, emphasize the link between digital and hard copy content as a means to extend and increase the effectiveness of political messaging. Augmented reality mailpieces promote campaign messages in a way that engages voters.
- Postal Service webinars highlight key political industry topics.
- The Postal Service has sponsorship agreements with the American Association of Political Consultants and Campaigns and Elections to help promote the use of mail early and often in the political arena. Activities include:
 - Attending events and co-sponsored webinars,
 - Advertising and white paper development and placement, and
- Direct meetings with political operatives.

Tag 57

Tag 57, *Political Campaign Mailing,* is a red container tag used to identify Political Mail while it's in the mail stream. Tag 57 can be used in the following ways:

- In a Political Campaign Mailing by a registered political candidate, campaign committee, and committee of a political party; or
- In a Political Message Mailing by a PAC, super-PAC, or other organization engaging in issue advocacy or voter mobilization.

According to *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service,* Domestic Mail Manual (DMM[®]), a *registered political candidate or party* is defined as an individual or organization recognized by a government election control authority (national, state, or local).

FAQs

1. What is Election Mail?

Election Mail is any item mailed to or from authorized election officials that enables citizens to participate in the voting process, such as balloting materials, voter registration cards, absentee applications, and polling place notifications.

2. What is Political Mail?

Political Mail includes Political Campaign Mail and Political Message Mail.

- Political Campaign Mail is any material mailed at First-Class Mail or USPS Marketing Mail prices for political campaign purposes by a registered political candidate, a campaign committee (federal, state, or local), or a committee of a political party (e.g., Democratic National Committee or Republican Congressional Campaign Committee) to promote political candidates, referendums, or political campaigns.
- Political Message Mail is any material mailed at First-Class Mail or USPS Marketing Mail prices by a PAC, super-PAC, or other organization engaging in issue advocacy or voter mobilization.

Political Mail may be sent for any public election — partisan or nonpartisan — for which there is a ballot. Political Mail is identified using red Tag 57, *Political Campaign Mailing*.

3. What is Vote-By-Mail?

A ballot is automatically mailed to every registered voter in advance of Election Day. Traditional in-person voting precincts are not available, but there are multiple ways and locations for voters to return mail ballots.

4. What is No Excuse Absentee Voting?

All states will mail an absentee ballot to certain voters who request one. The voter must return the ballot by mail or in person. According to the National Conference of State Legislatures, 20 states require a voter to provide an excuse, while 27 states and the District of Columbia permit any qualified voter to vote absentee without offering an excuse. Some states offer a permanent absentee ballot list. Once a voter asks to be added to the list, and is added by the election jurisdiction, he or she will automatically receive an absentee ballot for all future elections.

5. What are Absentee Ballots?

An absentee ballot is completed and typically mailed in advance of an election by a voter who is unable to be present at the polls.

6. What is Franked Mail?

Franked Mail is official mail sent by members and members-elect of Congress, the Vice-President, and other authorized individuals. Mail must relate to the mailer's official business, activities, and duties. Franked Mail has a written or facsimile signature of an authorized user in the upper right corner of the envelope or a franked label, followed by approved markings such as "M.C." (member of Congress) or "U.S.S." (U.S. Senate). A Franked Mail label is required for items larger than a flat-sized envelope. Franked Mail must not be returned for postage or delivered to the recipient as "postage due." Members of Congress are banned from sending Franked Mail mass mailings within a certain period of time (90 days for the House of Representatives and 60 days for the Senate) before a primary or general election in which the member is a candidate. Mass mailings contain 500 pieces or more that are substantially similar, subject to certain exceptions.

Franked Mailings (identified by Tag 11, *Congressional Mail*) are **NOT** eligible to use the red Tag 57. Franked Mail must be dispatched and delivered as addressed, and must not be detained, except for mail security.

7. How many states use Vote-By-Mail?

According to the National Conference of State Legislatures:

- Twenty-seven states and the District of Columbia permit any qualified voter to vote absentee without offering an excuse.
- Oregon, Washington, and Colorado hold all elections by mail.
- In addition to Oregon, Washington, and Colorado, 19 states allow "certain types of elections" to be held entirely by mail.

8. What is the projected number of ballots the Postal Service will deliver for this year's elections?

The Postal Service handled more than 20 million return ballots (not including military ballots) in the last midterm election, and more ballots are expected this year.

9. In the 2016 general election, how many ballots were delivered to troops around the world?

Between September 1 and December 10, 2016, the Military Postal Service postmarked and dispatched 51,531 voted absentee ballots to local election offices using Priority Mail Express Military[®] Service. Local election officials reported receiving a total of 27,504 non-voted absentee ballots. The average transit time for voted ballots returning to election offices was 4.3 working days or 4.9 calendar days.

10. Is the Postal Service ready for the increased volume?

Yes. U.S. Mail services are an important part of the U.S. election process. The Postal Service is confident in its ability to offer dependable and timely delivery of Election Mail and Political Mail.

11. What is the Hatch Act?

The Hatch Act (5 U.S.C. §§ 7321–7326) limits certain political activities for most executive branch employees. For example, the law prohibits employees from engaging in political activity while on duty or in the Federal workplace. The Hatch Act also prohibits executive branch employees from soliciting or receiving political contributions. Employees who violate the Hatch Act are subject to a range of disciplinary actions, including the following:

- Removal from federal service,
- Reduction in grade,
- Debarment from federal employment for a period not to exceed 5 years, and
- Suspension, reprimand, or a civil penalty not to exceed \$1,000.

12. How does the Hatch Act affect the Postal Service and its employees?

The Postal Service is non-political, which means the organization cannot and does not support any political party or affiliation over another. The continued effectiveness of this organization depends on delivering all political mailings without giving the perception that the views of one candidate, political party, or political viewpoint are endorsed over another.

It is the responsibility of all Postal Service employees to know and obey Hatch Act restrictions. This means that employees may not display political buttons while on Postal Service property or place bumper stickers on a Postal Service vehicle that indicate a preference for a specific candidate, party, or political position. Employees are also urged not to participate in any political discussions where customers are present.

13. Does the Postal Service process mail less frequently now than it used to?

No. Mail is processed daily.

14. Do the return ballots need to be postmarked by a certain date?

That varies on a state-by-state basis. There are currently 13 states that will accept postmarked ballots post-election in certain circumstances: AK, AR, CA, IA, IL, MD, NC, ND, NY, OH, UT, WA, and WV. Some states, like Alabama, require a valid postmark for a ballot to be counted. Go to your state's election website for specific information.

15. Do the return ballots need to be postmarked even if there is a meter?

- 1. Bear a unique IMb printed on the mailpiece;
- Include a Full-Service or OneCode ACS STID in the IMb;
- 3. Include the unique IMb in eDoc;
- 4. Be sent by an eDoc submitter:
 - a. Providing accurate Mail Owner identification in eDoc, and;
 - b. Maintaining 95-percent Full-Service compliance to remain eligible for this service and undergo periodic Postal Service re-evaluation.
- e. Green & Secure: Mailpieces using a STID for ACS Change Service Requested, with or without Secure Destruction, will not be subject to assessment under Move Update Verification using the Address Quality Census Measurement and Assessment Process under 602.5.3. Details are available in Publication 685, *Publication for Streamlined Mail Acceptance for Letters and Flats,* available at *postalpro.usps.com*.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service[™] money order:

- Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international Postal Service money orders.
- 2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word "USPS" repeated.
 - When there is discoloration around the dollar amounts, this might indicate the amounts were changed.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card, or online at usps.com/shop/money-orders.htm.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals, including in their raw, unmanufactured state, are prohibited. Official Mail shipments are exempt from this restriction.

B. Regardless of mail class, a customs declaration (PS Form 2976, PS Form 2976-A, or PS Form 2976-B) is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more or any item (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from this ZIP Code. All PMEMS mailpieces (regardless of mail contents or weight) addressed to or from this ZIP Code must bear a properly completed PS Form 2976-B. The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters or printed matter, except for Priority Mail Express, which requires a customs form for all contents and weights. (A known mailer is a business mailer who enters volume mailings through a business mail entry unit (BMEU) or other bulk mail acceptance location, pays postage through an advance deposit account, uses a permit imprint for postage payment, and submits a completed postage statement at the time of entry that certifies that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail" are exempt from providing customs documentation on any item addressed to an MPO except for those MPOs to which restriction "B2" applies and except for Priority Mail Express, which requires a customs form from all mailers.
- If mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use Exempt from Customs Requirements.'

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this MPO or DPO.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products, including tobacco leaves, chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, and cigars are prohibited, including those that are authorized in Publication 52 under PACT.

C1. Obscene and horror articles, images, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, comic books, etc., are prohibited.

C2. E-cigarettes and related products (e.g., nicotine liquids, e-liquids, parts, or supplies) are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E. Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as Official Mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.

E1. Mailers are responsible to ensure that all medicines and vaccines conform to host nation laws.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic, or sexual items are prohibited. Non-authorized political materials are prohibited. Religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, but individual items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless/cellular telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited, except firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed from this MPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms do not require an ATF form.

F1. Weapons of any type are prohibited.

F2. Mailing firearms to or from this MPO ZIP Code is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

F3. Replica weapons and inert explosive devices (such as grenades) and weapons parts are prohibited.

G. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, and wool samples whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under Publication 52, Part 421, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

S. Synthetic cannabinoids used to stimulate the central nervous system commonly known as "synthetic marijuana," "K2," or "Spice" are prohibited.

T. Mailings of household shipments and case lots of food to or from an MPO require military transportation office approval prior to mailing. Mailings to or from a DPO require pre-approval from the Diplomatic Pouch and Mail Director.

U. Mail addressed to Retirees (Box R) is limited to 16 ounces and up to a 90-day supply of TRICARE medications. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped.'

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail items, including audio and video media, weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to Official Mail.

U2. Retirees (Box R) are not authorized mail service.

U3. Reserved for future use.

U4. Mail addressed to Box C is limited to 2 lbs.

V. PMEMS is not available.

V1. Electronic Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com. Manual record of delivery may be available upon reauest

W. Hermetically sealed packages of meat products bearing USDA certification, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed. 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Cremated remains are prohibited.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail and Priority Mail items only. This restriction also applies to Official Mail.





On May 23, 2018, in La Jolla, CA, the U.S. Postal Service[®] will issue the *Sally Ride* stamp (Forever[®] priced at the First-Class Mail[®] rate) in one design, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive pane of 20 stamps (Item 477300). The stamp will go on sale nationwide May 23, 2018.

America's first woman in space, Dr. Sally Ride (1951– 2012), inspired the nation as a pioneering astronaut, brilliant physicist, and dedicated educator. The stamp art, sketched first in charcoal and then rendered in oil paint, features a colorful portrait of Ride in her light blue space suit with a dramatic depiction of a space shuttle lifting off in the background. Art director Ethel Kessler designed the stamp with artwork by Paul Salmon.


Availability to Post Offices: Item 477300, Sally Ride (Forever Priced at the First-Class Mail Rate) Commemorative Pane of 20 Stamps

Stamp Fulfillment Services will make an automatic push distribution to Post Offices[™] of a quantity to cover approximately 30 days of sales. Distribution quantities for the automatic push distribution will be available by logging on to SFS Web at *sfsweb.usps.gov*. Post Offices may begin ordering stamps on the first-day-of-issue through SFS Web; offices must also check the amount they will receive in their automatic push distribution.

Special Dedication Postmarks

Only the following pictorial postmark is permitted for the *Sally Ride* stamp. The word "Station" or the abbreviation "STA" is required somewhere in the design, because it will be a temporary station.

Guidelines for Finalizing the Sally Ride Stamp Pictorial Postmark Art



To finalize the *Sally Ride* stamp pictorial postmark art, insert the date, city, state, and ZIP Code[™] of the physical location of your event adjacent to the stamp image. Overall dimensions of the pictorial postmark must not exceed 4 inches horizontally by 2 inches vertically. Collectors prefer the dimensions 3-1/2 inches by 1.

The Postal Service[™] must make all special postmarks known to collectors through advance publicity in the *Postal Bulletin.* Therefore, all special dedication cancellations must be reported to Stamp Services 4 weeks before the event using PS Form 413, *Pictorial Postmark Announcement/ Report.* To get a copy of the form, go to *blue.usps.gov/ formmgmt/forms/ps413.pdf.*

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Postmark

Customers have 120 days to obtain the first-day-ofissue postmark by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office or at The Postal Store[®] website at *usps.com/shop*. 
As a community service, the Postal Service[™] offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears on the following pages. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office[™] station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail[®] postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserviced.


Customers wishing to obtain a postmark must affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4[®] Code, as listed next to the postmark.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.



Customers have 120 days to obtain the first-day-ofissue postmarks by mail. Each cover must have sufficient postage to meet First-Class Mail® requirements. Customers may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office[™], by phone at 800- 782-6724, or on The Postal Store® website at usps.com/shop.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service[™] recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16-inch side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2 inches high by 4 inches long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers must submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers must affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. 



Supply Management

eBuy2 Purchases of 5-Gallon Bottled Drinking Water Services for the Remaining 6 Months of FY 2018

Please be aware that the current eBuy2 purchase timeframe for 5-gallon bottled drinking water service is 6 months (March 31–September 30, 2018).

All sites purchasing 5-gallon bottled water service from Nestle (marketed as Arrowhead, Calistoga, Deer Park, Ice Mountain, Ozarka, Poland Spring, or Zephyrhills) or from DS Waters (marketed as Alhambra, Belmont, Crystal Springs, Hinckley Springs, Kentwood Springs, Sierra Springs, or Sparkletts) are required to reorder "on-catalog" via eBuy2.

All requisitions for the remaining 6 months of fiscal year (FY) 2018 must be processed and approved before April 20, 2018, to avoid a lapse in service. The Postal Service[™] requires requisitions to be processed during this period because the supplier needs to have your FY 2018 on-catalog requisition in the eBuy2 system to invoice your FEDSTRIP.

Note: Some sites cannot receive service directly from Nestle or DS Waters. These sites are authorized to purchase "off-catalog" as long as Nestle or DS Waters have stated that they will not provide service to those specific locations. Locations wishing to renew bottled water service for FY 2018 must note the following to ensure uninterrupted service:

- When submitting orders on eBuy2, estimate how much product your office will need for the last 6 months of FY 2018.
- All orders must match the Area for which they belong; eBuy2 orders with items for mixed Areas will be cancelled.
- Customers must enter cooler and dispenser rentals for the last 6 months of FY 2018.
- Customers ordering cups must estimate and request enough for the last 6 months of FY 2018.
- For DS Waters customers only for every bottle of water ordered, there must be an equal bottle deposit quantity ordered.

Earth Day and USPS Annual Sustainability Report

April 22 marks the anniversary of what many consider the birth of the modern environmental movement in 1970. At the time, air pollution was commonly accepted as the smell of prosperity. After witnessing the aftermath of a massive 1969 oil spill in Santa Barbara, California, Gaylord Nelson, then a U.S. Senator from Wisconsin, came up with the idea of "Earth Day." Senator Nelson realized that if he could raise public awareness of air and water pollution, environmental protection would become part of the national political agenda.

Every Earth Day, USPS[®] Sustainability team releases its *Annual Sustainability Report* to share the results of successful initiatives. The report is read by customers, members of Congress, competitors, business owners, and Postal Service[™] employees.

Sustainability and the Triple Bottom Line

Sustainability is all about balancing the needs of people, planet, and profit to ensure a viable U.S. Postal Service[®] that provides affordable, universal service for current and future generations. Some people refer to this idea as the triple bottom line of sustainability. Currently, Postal Service[™] employees are working hard to ensure sustainability, though they may not realize it.



By publishing the *Annual Sustainability Report*, the Postal Service demonstrates leadership and transparency. Stakeholder groups prioritize sustainability efforts critical to postal operations, and these initiatives are featured in the report along with performance metrics to help readers understand the impact of our results.

Consequently, congratulations are in order for both the Great Lakes Area and the Northeast Area. Last year, they were awarded regional WasteWise awards by the Environmental Protection Agency for their achievements in sustainable waste management. For more information, check out the 2017 *Annual Sustainability Report*, which is scheduled to be posted on the Sustainability team website soon.

Any time a facility undergoes an Environmental Compliance Review, Postal Service employees are doing their part to help protect the environment, which is the "planet" part of sustainability. And by participating in the Annual Food Drive or Combined Federal Campaign, Postal Service employees exhibit good social responsibility in their communities, which is the "people" part of sustainability. However, one aspect of sustainability is often overlooked sustainability is good for business.

How Does Sustainability Benefit Our Business?

- Environmental compliance reduces the risks and associated costs of non-compliance.
- Diverting waste from landfills reduces trash disposal costs.
- The sale of recyclables increases revenue while helping the environment.

Last year, the U.S. Postal Service diverted over half of their trash to recycling, mostly through the National Recycling Operation. In this program, Undeliverable Standard Mail is backhauled from Post Offices[™] to distribution centers and plants for consolidation (see *blue.usps.gov/sustainability/national-recycling-operation.htm*).

Employees' recycling efforts last year resulted in over \$7 million in trash disposal cost savings compared to the previous year, and generated nearly \$16 million in revenue. This is the "profit" part of sustainability.

In support of the triple bottom line, the Postal Service is pleased to share details about our latest sustainability initiatives.

New Waste Management Contract

The Postal Service has awarded a new contract for universal waste management to Cleanlites Recycling, Inc. You can find contract information in the Material Logistics Bulletin, MLB-CO-18-003 (see *blue.usps.gov/purchase/_pdf/ops_mlb18-003.pdf*). The scope of available services includes:

- Waste pick-up,
- Transportation,
- Labeling,
- Waste profiling,
- Bill of lading preparation,
- Waste recycling, and
- Waste disposal.

The contract covers the following types of waste and related supplies:

- Batteries, including universal waste batteries (e.g., nickel-cadmium, nickel-metal hydride, lithium, lithium-ion, silver/mercury oxide, and small, sealed lead-acid batteries) and alkaline batteries;
- Lamps (light bulbs), including universal waste lamps (e.g., fluorescent and compact fluorescent lamps, high intensity discharge lamps, neon lamps, and LED lamps);
- Light ballasts that do not contain polychlorinated biphenyls;
- Mercury-containing equipment (e.g., thermometers, thermostats, electrical switches); and
- Containers and other supplies, as needed, to properly collect, store, and transport waste materials.

The Cleanlites Recycling, Inc. contract does *not* include any mailback services or pick-up/management services for vehicle batteries, industrial lead-acid batteries (e.g., forklift and towmotors), pesticides and herbicides, or state-specific universal wastes (e.g., Colorado aerosol cans or Texas paint and paint-related waste). These services are available through other suppliers in eBuy2.

Universal Waste Management

Universal waste includes certain batteries, lamps, and mercury-containing equipment. Because these items contain toxic material(s), universal waste has specific federally mandated management and recycling requirements. Postal Service sites must clearly label and store universal waste in closed containers and properly train employees to manage these wastes. Additionally, sites must arrange for universal waste pick-up (or mailback) and subsequent offsite recycling within one year (365 days) of the day the waste was generated. Postal Service sites must also maintain recycling records. For more information about universal waste management requirements, see the following environmental compliance bulletins:

Hydrogen Fuel Cell Pilot



Hydrogen fuel cell pilot test results from the Washington National Distribution Center (NDC) are in — the Postal Service realized over \$3.5 million in annual cost-avoidance and operational savings.

In 2016, the Postal Service replaced lead-acid batteries with hydrogen fuel cells in all the power industrial vehicles (PIV) at the Washington NDC. First year pilot results include the following:

- Manpower savings from productivity improvements;
- Elimination of lead-acid battery system costs;
- Electricity savings; and
- 11,000 work hour savings.

PIV operator productivity increased by approximately 27 percent (as measured by the number of containers handled per hour). Hydrogen fuel cells also reduced down time for maintenance and refueling, provided steady voltage, and reduced greenhouse gas emissions. Over a 5-year period, the hydrogen fuel cells are projected to save as much as \$19 million.

Utility Management System

Used by more than 5,600 USPS[®] facilities, the Utility Management System (UMS) captures billing and consumption data in a centralized, electronic repository. The objective is to track utility consumption and spend data so the Postal Service can reduce utility costs. Key elements of UMS include:

Bill Pay Process

- Uses third party utility bill review and payment services.
- Identifies billing errors and excessive usage.
- Eliminates late payment fees and penalties.
- Reduces work hours for field accounting personnel.

Data Capture and Reporting

- Reports facility energy usage to the Department of Energy.
- Complies with Environmental Protection Agency guidelines to set baseline, goals, and targets for energy improvements.

Tax Recoupment

- Identifies state and local taxes and tracks account compliance.
- Provides notices on expired tax exempt certifications.

Energy Programs

Provides an opportunity to participate in rate optimization and energy-saving programs at available sites.

EnergyUnited/CAPTURIS processes all invoices for the participating facilities. Utility bills and consumption data are captured and reviewed to flag inconsistencies. In FY 2017, the total energy spend for participating facilities was \$402 million. For more information about cost savings, visit *link.usps.com/2015/04/29/follow-the-money/*.

Secure Destruction Mail Service Helps Sustain the Future of U.S. Mail

The Postal Service works hard every day to increase the value of our brand by offering new, innovative services that meet the needs of business customers. That's why the Postal Service developed the Secure Destruction (SD) mail service program. SD mail service provides mailers with a more sustainable and cost-effective way to manage letter-size First-Class Mail[®] containing protected personal information (PPI). Currently, the Postal Service is diligently working to expand SD mail service by extending it to flat-sized First-Class Mail. For Earth Day 2018, mailers can help make the mail more sustainable by using value-added programs like SD mail service and other USPS BlueEarth[®] sustainability services.

What is SD Mail Service?

SD mail service is an opt-in program offered by the U.S. Postal Service as part of USPS BlueEarth sustainability service initiative. SD mail service ensures that letter-sized Undeliverable-As-Addressed (UAA) First-Class Mail containing PPI that would otherwise be returned to sender is securely shredded and recycled. Here is the SD mail service process:

- 1. Letter-size First-Class Mail enters USPS processing facility.
- 2. UAA mail is labeled and sorted for secure destruction.
- 3. All UAA mail is verified by USPS employees before destruction.
- 4. All verified mail is fed into an industrial cross-cut shredder at USPS processing facility.
- 5. USPS processing facilities recycle the shredded mail.

SD Mail Service Benefits

SD mail service is good for business and the environment. UAA mail is securely destroyed within USPS processing facilities to keep PPI safe. Also, recycling and eliminating unnecessary reverse logistics (returning physical mailpieces to senders) reduces the carbon footprint of UAA mail. Both the mailers and the Postal Service save money by reducing operational costs.

Who Should Use SD Mail Service?

Companies or agencies currently internally destroying return to sender mail containing PPI, such as:

- Health records protected under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996;
- Financial records protected under the Financial Services Modernization Act of 1999;
- Consumer records protected by state security breach notification laws;
- Federal government records protected under the Privacy Act of 1974;
- Credit card records governed by payment card industry data security standards; and
- Personal records that create liabilities for companies or customers if they are not securely destroyed.

How to Register for SD Mail Service

Mailers interested in SD mail service must use the following options to register:

■ A Mailer Identifier (Mailer ID or MID) is required for Intelligent Mail[®] barcode (IMbTM) mail. Use your existing account or register to get a Mailer ID for letter-size Full Service or Basic IMb First-Class Mail. For more information, visit *postalpro.usps.com/mailing/ secure-destruction.*


- Use your existing account or register for a Single-Source Address Change Service (ACS[™]), OneCode ACS[®], or Traditional ACS account. To open an ACS account, send an email to the ACS Department at acs@usps.gov or call 877-640-0724, option 1.
- Use your existing Electronic Product Fulfillment (EPF) account or complete an EPF Web Access Request form (see *epf.usps.gov/*).
- Complete the SD enrollment form (see *postal-pro.usps.com/node/614*).
- Use the appropriate SD Service Type Identifier based on ACS type and ancillary service options.

Go Green in 2018
