The 2019 All Craft Conference will be held Monday, October 28, 2019 through Wednesday, October 30, 2019 at Bally's Las Vegas, 3645 South Las Vegas Blvd., Las Vegas, NV 89109, (800) 358-8777. The conference will include craft specific general business sessions where issues and resolutions will be discussed and voted on.

For APWU members registering, an \$85 registration fee will be charged to cover the cost of materials. A late registration fee of \$135 will be incurred after 5:00 pm EST on Monday, September 16, 2019. Members may pre-register and pay online at [www.apwu.org](http://www.apwu.org).

There will be a Young Members meeting held on Saturday, October 26, 2019. All APWU members 35 and under are encouraged to attend the meeting.

An All-Craft Legislative and Political Conference and Training Session will be held on Sunday, October 27, 2019. A \$50 registration fee will be charged through 5:00 pm EST on Monday, September 16, 2019. A late registration fee of \$55 will be charged after 5:00 pm EST on Monday, September 16, 2019. Please note that the registration fee includes a boxed lunch.

Registration for the APWU Retirees Department General Session and workshops is separate from the registration listed above. A \$40 registration fee will be charged through 5:00 pm EST on Monday, September 16, 2019. A late registration fee of \$45 will be charged after 5:00 pm EST on Monday, September 16, 2019.

Information regarding classes that will be offered will be available on the APWU website in early May. Registration for all events listed above will open during this time as well.

Members are asked to stay at Bally's Las Vegas, where the APWU has negotiated a discounted room rate of \$129/night plus tax, which includes the \$30 resort fee. The resort fee includes unlimited local phone calls, two (2) guest admission per day to the fitness center and in-room internet to include two (2) devices per room, per day. Please note that the hotel does not allow more than four (4) people per room. Reservations can be made online or by calling 800-358-8777 and using group code SBAWU9. To book online, please visit [www.apwu.org](http://www.apwu.org). Please note that reservations made via the call center will be assessed a fee of \$15 plus current sales tax, per reservation. This fee does not apply to reservations made via the Internet.

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Please visit [www.apwu.org](http://www.apwu.org) for more information on making hotel reservations online. The cut off for reservations based on the negotiated rate is Monday, September 30, 2019. After this time rooms may not be available at the group rate.

Please note that the hotel does require a valid major credit card for reservations. Checks can be used, however, they must be received by the hotel at least thirty (30) days in advance of the arrival date on the reservations. Checks will not be accepted onsite. If a local or state organization wishes to pay for the reservations via check, please contact Hannah Decker at [hdecker@apwu.org](mailto:hdecker@apwu.org) for additional information. Upon check in, there will be a \$50 per day hold on credit and debit cards to cover any incidental charges that may be incurred.

Resolutions shall be submitted in writing/electronically to the Division Director at least thirty (30) days in advance of the division (craft) conference. All resolutions should be received by Thursday, September 26, 2019. Resolutions are accepted from local or state affiliates, or from Members-at-Large (MALs). Resolutions from local or state affiliates must be submitted electronically. MALs are the only individuals who may submit resolutions under their own signatures. Resolutions from MALs must be sent directly to Secretary-Treasurer Elizabeth Powell. They must be typed, double-spaced and submitted individually (one resolution per page) to 1300 L Street, NW, Washington, DC 20005.


