

URGENT ELECTION NOTICE

TO FULL CASH-PAYING DUES MEMBERS

According to the official records of the American Postal Workers Union (APWU), we are unable to determine whether you meet the criteria as a member in good standing, eligible to vote in the APWU 2019 National Officers Election.

Article 12, Section 2 of the APWU National Constitution and Bylaws provides in part: *"To be eligible to vote, a member must be in good standing according to the official records of the national Union on the last day of the first full pay period in June of the election year."* This provision requires that you must have paid your full local dues through **Friday, June 21, 2019**.

In order for your vote to count, you must present proof to the Election Committee showing that you have met the above-cited constitutional requirement as a member in good standing.

If you fail to present proof (e.g. copy of a cancelled check, receipt or letter from your local indicating that you have paid full local dues), your ballot will be voided and will not be counted. In order to preserve the secrecy of your ballot, be sure to include your proof of eligibility in the OUTER return envelope, not the secret ballot envelope. We appreciate your cooperation.
