We plan for the investigation to be completed by 1/18/21. When we have completed our investigation, you will be informed of the findings and asked to attend a disciplinary hearing.

You may also be asked to attend an investigation meeting with the person in charge to explain on account of what happened. If this is the case, you will be provided with a date and time in advance. A USPS union representative will be available to assist you.
